Headlines/Key Issues

- Successful delivery of Wiltshire Family Learning programmes 16/17 working in partnership with Noremarsh Junior School and St Bartholomew's.
- Recruitment supported by schools, children's centre and Parent Support Adviser; Family Learning programmes funded by Education Skills Funding Agency and must engage with learners who haven't achieved a L2 English/maths; aim to support so can achieve L2 qualifications and offer signposting opportunities to progress to further learning and employment.

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- Family SEAL – 14 learners completed course @ St Bartholomew's
 - Family Animation – 3 learners completed course at Noremarsh
 - Family Functional Skills English 2 learners achieved L2 English qualification at Noremarsh (1 learner attended and still to complete)
 - 3 learners attending Family Learning Employability programme post qualification

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- Key issues were recruitment of appropriate learners; low number on courses; will broaden offer to Cricklade using on the ground knowledge and link up with Cricklade Children's Centre for recruitment. Families may access courses using transport.

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
