- b) Regular emails from the council's waste and recycling team with recycling information, leaflets and updates- 4%
- c) Social media updates from Wiltshire Council regarding recycling information and facts- 4%
- d) Stickers on the bins specifying what can and can't go into them- 37%
- e) An information leaflet posted to all households- 14%
- f) None of these I recycle all I can anyway- 37%

- 4. Which of the following would most encourage you to recycle more at home?
- a) Information on comparative costs of putting recyclables into the non-recycled waste bin- 0%
- b) Information on comparative environmental impacts of putting recyclables into the non-recycled waste bin- 5%
- c) If there was an incentive for you to recycle more- 33%
- d) If there were penalties in place for not recycling- 5%
- e) None of these I recycle all I can anyway- 57%
