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The Wiltshire Joint Strategic Needs Assessment highlights childhood obesity as a key issue - this project will provide raised awareness in local families for the need to eat healthily through recipe bags sent home with the children. This project is designed to reach families from all backgrounds, excluding no one. The sessions promote national initiatives such as 5ADAY and Change 4 Life, encouraging families to make healthy choices which in turn reduces health problems. The emphasis is on prevention rather than cure and aims to reduce obesity in children by embedding in them from a very young age the importance of eating sensibly and exercising.
