We can cover the normal running costs, but we are hoping the grant would support the inclusion of the Parish Councils and local Businesses, attracting tourists and residents of nearby villages to the event.

For forward planning purposes we would like to bring together parish representatives and other interested parties to an event for partnership cohesion to be held in February in Durrington village hall.
