**What is the link between your project and other local priorities?** e.g. Priorities set by your area board and parish plans.

The Parish Plan has shown the need to expand and consolidate sporting activities in the village. The provision of a cricket pitch is the least risk option which can be clearly undertaken to solve the requirement for improving a team sport for both young and old.

**How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?**

The only sports team in the village is the cricket club, which comprises members aged from 10 to 60. The club was formed in 1999 and, apart from 1 game, all home matches have been played on a high priced MoD pitch some 5 miles away. Thus, match fees are high and, in some cases, hard to meet; the following of the team is limited. There has been strong backing for getting cricket back into the village to provide relaxing entertainment and revive the scene of a traditional English village. There are already cricket nets which are used extensively for practice with members of the cricket team spending a great deal of time coaching the youngsters. For 4 years a member of the team has been coaching children from the local Primary School (as an extra curricula activity). The school has been entering a local area schools 'Kwik cricket' competition and has progressed to reach the top 9; with a pitch, more success would be anticipated. The whole project not only provides a great opportunity for this village but, by providing the only pitch in the Bourne Valley, it will bring together other communities who will be able to make use of the facility. The cricket club is open for all to join.

The Village Hall will house the cricket equipment which will be freely available to all to use at any time.

The Cricket Club is very involved in this project and will be sponsoring several fund raising events to get further finance for for the pitch and the various sundries which go with it.

The use of the pitch will be available for other villages both in the Bourne valley and elsewhere; the Club would also be available.
