Crucially, it has the potential to provide a wide community							
benefit that will serve to encourage people to come together to enjoy a cinematic experience with their friends, families and neighbours. WHPI is being launched as a three year pilot project with a viability review after year one. The grant applied for will allow the project the greatest possible chance of success by
