Twinning is a concept where towns from geographical areas are linked, with the goal of fostering human contact and cultural links. This can be likened to a scaled up version of a 'pen pal' scheme, where the 'pals' are whole towns (or cities). Each town can acquire knowledge of each other's way of life, discuss mutual problems, form cultural and social links, exchange visits and develop friendships. Annual visits are made to either Charlieu or Eningen, where members receive a friendly welcome and stay with host families. In turn the host towns, through their Twinning Associations, send regular groups to Calne. New and lasting friendships are made and there are many common interests and hobbies. Links also exist with the Calne Silver Band and the pupil exchange scheme through The John Bentley School.
