Neighbourhood Watch is about keeping residents and their property, safe.</p> <p>The NHW Scheme in Wiltshire is currently being reinvigorated and there is a need for new signs & stickers to be installed where new NHW schemes are introduced and also to replace old, worn out or damaged signs and stickers for existing schemes.</p> <p>The signs and stickers will be made available to Chippenham Area Board Division Councillors to deploy in their divisions in appropriate locations. Locations will be identified and agreed in partnership with local Neighbourhood Police Team.</p>
