<u>H7,</u> I7 <u>, J6, K7</u> and J7	Amend pre-submission settlement boundary to follow but not include the High Street on the north side, thereby excluding the houses on the south side of the High Street. This is isolated development that is physically detached from the settlement.
H7 and H8	Amend pre-submission settlement boundary to continue the southern boundary west to join the neighbouring property. This would follow a clearly defined physical feature, e.g. walls or hedgerows, and include the curtilage of a property that relates more closely to the built environment (e.g. a garden) and has limited capacity to extend the built form of the settlement in terms of scale and location.
