As previously stated the project fits in well, we believe, with the Community Plan. The parish of Bishops Cannings does not appear to have a Plan. However we believe provision of sporting activities, especially for young people in rural areas is of paramount importance

**How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?**

As a result of an increasing number of youth players (1) receiving coaching at the Club (over 80) the three permanent astro nets and the actual cricket field are in heavy use on coaching evenings - with out particular emphasis on one to one coaching of individuals. the addition of a mobile net would enormously enhance our provision for such coaching with its flexibility and mobility. All youth members will benefit. (2) We have approximately 120 games of cricket played at our ground each season from U11 to 4 mens teams and we also host several youth County games. there is an important need to provide sight screens for these games allowing the ball to be seen by the batsmen. Lack of finance has denied us this in the past. All members of the Club will benefit markedly. (3) If we improve the quality of our artificial pitch our middle practices will be far better and we will be able to host games in the pitch when the weather doesn't allow grass to be used.
