The Club boasts 78 playing members plus a junior Academy section comprising in excess of 140 members including a thriving girls section. The staircase is in daily use throughout the season (April to September) and as well as our own members is used by all visiting teams. The existing staircase is of wooden construction and was erected in 1999. Over the last couple of seasons it has rotted in places involving significant expenditure on repairs (£1400 in 2008) with further repairs of £525 needed to make it safe. It is proposed to replace it with a staircase of steel construction which over a longer period will significantly reduce maintenance costs
