

Lovell Area Board Partner Update

Lovell are pleased to report progress continues at a pace across the Salisbury Plain Training Area Service Family Accommodation Project. The Bulford and Ludgershall SFA estates were completed during this past summer. The Bulford SFA entrance at Double Hedges is now open and we are currently completing the landscaping works at this entrance. The Plumer Estate is now home for more than 150 Service families. At the Ludgershall site, the construction compound is now fully cleared and we anticipate the completion of landscaping works in the coming months. The Corunna Estate is now a thriving part of the Ludgershall community with a vast number of new residents. The Larkhill SFA site construction continues with delivery of circa 14-15 homes per week to our client, the DIO. As of November 12, 2019, we have delivered 182 Service Family Homes at Larkhill and we are happy to confirm that the project continues to progress ahead of our target programme.

Further to the recent Tidworth Area Board Community Awards, we were delighted to be invited to receive, alongside the LGWCG, the local community award for the renovation of the Ludgershall Centenary Garden. We were pleased to assist in this community endeavour and remain very proud of the garden and that Lovell have been able to contribute towards this legacy for the local community.
