APPROVAL FOR CORONA VIRUS STAFFING POLICY

Decision made

To approve the Corona Virus Staffing Policy

Background

1. Pursuant to paragraph 4 of Part 3 Section D, the Directors of Wiltshire Council are empowered to take all necessary decisions in cases of emergency. This decision is being taken by Joanne Pitt using these powers in circumstances where the Director concerned believes that there is a risk of damage to property, a threat to the health or wellbeing of an individual and/or that the interests of the Council may be compromised if this decision is not otherwise taken.

Reason for decision

2. This decision would in other circumstances be taken by Staffing Policy Committee. However, in circumstances where the Staffing Policy Committee is unable to meet to expedite its functions in a timely manner during the COVID-19 pandemic, this decision is being taken in accordance with the power referred to in paragraph 1 above, in consultation with Cllr Stuart Wheeler, Chair of the Staffing Policy Committee; Union Representatives; and Cllr Richard Clewer, the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Corporate Service. This decision will be reported to the next meeting of the Staffing Policy Committee.
3. The decision has been made to ensure that the Council is able to respond quickly and flexibly to staffing issues as they arise, to ensure that the Council is able to resource services to the most vulnerable in the community.


