We carried out a 12 hour traffic survey based on Wiltshire Council guidelines 7 <sup>th</sup> October 2008.							
During a 15 minute period in Hilmarton there were 308 traffic movements (A 2009 survey at Lyneham greater increase in traffic volume).	snows a
