This project is reliant upon the provision of a temporary support worker who has skills in both community development and environmental management, to facilitate the development of the group and ensure its sustainability. Part of this brief will be to identify and draw down funds from other funding streams and to create a sustainable action plan.

The group will also engage in fundraising activities.

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The Abberd Brook has been an issue for the Calne Area Board and is currently to subject of an Area Board working group.

Westlea Housing Assoc. has been investigating restoration work and consulting with local people for a number of years.

The Brook is also appearing as a significant emerging issue for CCAP as it reviews its community plan.

All Westlea residents and private residents in the locality will be specifically encouraged to become involved and are also the prime benefactors of the project. However the group will also promote the project beyond the area and hopes to draw down additional volunteers from further afield and the benefits will be felt more widely as more people begin to recognise the advantages of using this piece of community space in positive ways.
