Again, accounting for teacher training days which there is always at least one for teachers to start the academic year would make the holidays even longer. This length of school holiday is not viable for working parents most of who have 25 days of leave. Additionally, holiday clubs for children usually do not start this early in the holidays, as they usually begin at the start of the first full week of a school holiday, however leaving two days of a term in a week (which are likely to be turned into teacher training days) leave parents with the high possibility of not being able to find childcare. These half weeks of term/annual leave also mean that parents lose opportunities to spend full, productive weeks with their children in the school holidays when they can do more with them instead of covering time as either term ends or waits to begin. A longer October break would hopefully discourage out-of-term attendance in the winter term, although this half week of holiday is also difficult to find childcare for.	1
