litter picks). Everleigh appears to be getting cleaner!

Projects

- We have made good progress on our Everleigh Enhancement Plan over the past 2 years.
 Achievements include: a circular bench by The Crown bus shelter; a new all weather bench by the playground with views across Salisbury Plain; two caution horses signs on Netheravon Road; a floral garden on the embankment in Everleigh Centre; a superb village map to support delivery drivers by the bus stop layby; and the establishment of flower planters throughout the village.
- This year our priorities will be a new all weather bench in Everleigh Centre overlooking the floral garden, two additional planters to build on the success of that project and a Christmas Tree in December in Everleigh Centre.
