Krumbz cafe is located on a corner of a small residential road, overlooking the river, with the 'Town Mill' (a conurbation of residential maisonettes, most of which are retirement dwellings) on the other side. The layout of Kennet Place is such that should increase noise be an issue (due to the use of alcohol) it would carry around the immediate vicinity, impacting on the residential experience of both residents of Kennet Place and also Town Mill, and both changing and effecting the nature of the residential experience.

The Council felt having a licenced premises in this location would be moving the parameters of this activity wider and away from where licenced premises currently sit in the town.
