## 6 Assessment of Complaints: COC149256 and COC149258

In considering the complaint, the Sub-Committee were satisfied that the initial tests of the assessment criteria had been met, including that the Subject Member was a member for the period of allegations and remains a member of Salisbury City Council and Wiltshire Council, that copies of the relevant Codes of Conduct were provided for the assessment, and that they were acting in their capacity as a Member, or that the circumstances may have led to a reasonable presumption from those involved that he had been acting in an official capacity during the alleged actions.

The Sub-Committee therefore had to decide whether the alleged behaviour would, if proven, amount to a breach of that Code of Conduct. Further, if it was felt it would be a breach, whether it was still appropriate under the assessment criteria to refer the matter for investigation.

In reaching its decision, the Sub-Committee took into account the original complaint and supporting information, the response of the Subject Member, and the report of the Monitoring Officer.

The Sub-Committee also considered a written statement from the Subject Member and written statements from both of the Complainants provided at the Assessment Sub-Committee meeting.

After discussion, it was:

### Resolved:

In accordance with the approved arrangements for resolving standards complaints adopted by Council on 9 July 2019, which came into effect on 1 January 2020 and after hearing from the Independent Person, the Assessment Sub-Committee determined to refer the linked complaints for investigation.
