The Management Committee of the Hall organise a program of social events throughout the year which allows villagers from all parts of the community valuable regular get togethers. Whilst these events help raise money to maintain the Hall the amount raised is no where near sufficient to maintain a building built in 1854. When attending events villagers have commented on how uncomfortable the present seating is and the weight and awkwardness of the current chairs make them difficult to carry; to set up and to store.
