Until now, the group members have met on an ad-hoc basis to clear problem areas, where branches overhang footpath/bridleway trails, which are also used as informal cycleways. We have purchased our own hand tools for the purpose and some spares for the occasional willing volunteer. It is is clear to us that we can make a huge difference, with a little extra help and a good quality mechanical aid. Our needs are two fold One requirement is to purchase a brush cutter with pole pruner attachment and obtain the necessary training/user certificates for two members. This is the purpose of the grant request. Our other objective is to seek extra volunteers throughout the Parish, so that we can properly organise events, which can make a huge difference in each area we tackle.

Our grant application follows consultation with the WC Rights of Way Officer, Nick Cowen. He recommends these purchases as best value. Overall Project: WC will flail and widen certain bridleways and footpaths. Our volunteers will assist with further clearing at ground level and preparing the debris for chipping. WC will chip and lay on the ROW to improve the surface. We will maintain for the year.

We have no age barrier and already have a very wide age range, within the group. We believe that having formaised the group into "Clear Way", our purpose and identity will inspire likeminded people in the parish to join and help. The project meets the two key environmental objectives of our Parish Plan..
