

Overton, Lockeridge & Fyfield]. 2/ The Kennet Valley Heritage Group are a group of local volunteers who have been accumulating a large archive of old historic photos of the Valley for posterity. The plan is to produce a montage of many of these photos to create a pictorial display showing the social history of the Valley. The latter Montage would also be housed in an identical 8ft x 3ft frame to create a magnificent cultural display on one wall of the Kennet Valley Hall. The beneficiaries of all this hard work will be both the whole Community in it's present form, casual visitors, future generations of visitors, and not least the local children who will experience both a presentation of artistic culture and a historical lesson in the local Community's historical past. Clearly numbers and more specific data is impossible to provide.</p>

Difficult to add further to the earlier statement. This a major Community Project, which has been self funded by the two organisations involved who are both Community based with involvement by many local people/volunteers. Both organisations have no other sources of funding. The results of all this enterprise will be physically housed at the Village Hall which is the fulcrum of the local Community. All the Hall's own funds are dedicated to maintaining the fabric of the building and are all designated to futue maintenance requirements. Therefore we are requesting financial support in this way to cover the only capital costs involved, ie the frames themselves - which need to be custom built. For the sake of this Application we anticipate that these costs will not exceed £1000.

Apart from the volunteers involved to date we have already selected a small framing company in West Overton which will provide local commercial benefit. The actual quotation from this company is due any time.
