The project is two tiered: a) production of Organic vegetables b) a basic gardening service. We will engage people who are homeless, unemployed, or volunteers from local villages, to help run the gardening project, so increasing their skills base, promoting good work ethics and increasing confidence. We will provide support and training for those working with us. The Project will break down barriers and lead to social cohesion between homeless people and villagers. The organic vegetable part of the project will make available high quality vegetables at competative prices especially for those on low incomes, and will provide produce for soup run in the City, which enables people who are homeless, vulnerable and marginalised to eat a healthier diet. The gardening service is for the elderly, disabled and local village churches and will provide a basic service for those who are physically unable to look after their own gardens. The Project will benefit those who are homeless, disadvantaged, on low income, elderly, disabled, of all ages and gender. Approximate number of beneficiaries: 500.

Morning Star (Salisbury) is implementing a 3 year business plan, which includes a fundraising strategy. Our approach to fundraising includes applications to various grant-giving bodies and charitable trusts, our own community fundraising efforts, volunteer fundraising, tax-effective ways of giving, and donations. We have already secured part funding towards three years salary costs for the project worker who will be supervising this project, this is from Lloyds TSB Foundation.

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The charity's aim is to provide housing, emotional support and to create new opportunities, such as therapeutic help, for people at a time when they most need it in the context of a family environment with a Christian ethos. We provide clients, who have high support or intensive support needs, with the opportunity to discover and try out new coping strategies and life skills in a safe and supported environment with a high ratio of staff to clients in order that optimum results can be achieved for individuals. Morning Star currently has three main areas of activity. The provision of:1) Accommodation and support, for those who wish to turn their lives around from homelessness and substance misuse. Detox facilites are provided. The 12-step program is a theraputic project based on Cognitive Behaviour Therapy for those with substance misuse issues. 2) The "Banquet" Run for those who are homeless, vulnerable and/or disadvantaged. 3) Women Alive in Salisbury meeting provides support, friendship and a life-line for women who are vulnerable and disadvantaged. Success is measured by use of a short evalunation form. Goals set and reached by those who are homeless and unemployed. New friendships made and barriers broken down around issues of homelessness and addiction. We are an active networking partner and work closely with other statutory and voluntary agencies to ensure a clients needs are met. We engage with the public and communities by recruiting, training and using volunteers.
