Donhead St Mary PC are trustees of Donhead Sports Club which is a 10 acre field comprising 3 football pitches, used as a cricket pitch in summer, 2 tennis/multi use courts, adventure playground for young children and multi sports centre for all. The tennis/multi use courts will provide the following community benefits; Opportunities for whole community to play tennis, netball, football, cricket and attend community social events. The rural community of Donhead St Mary will have a sports/recreational facility in walking/cycling distance so that participation in activities can be accessed without the need for transport. Neighbouring parishes Donhead St Andrew, Semley & Tollard Royal can also use the facility as they do not have any facilities. Beneficiaries; Ludwell Primary School - (school roll 70 children 5 - 10 years) which is in walking distance. Will put on tennis lessons for Y6 every week (27 no.) After School Club meets twice a week (10 no.). Mothers can benefit from facilities whilst their children are at the After School Clubs, and younger siblings can enjoy the play equipment. Donhead Sports Club - 166 members, 40 of which are tennis members. The courts will be used everyday during spring/summer & twice/week winter. Age range: 5-80 Football Club (will use the courts for 6 a side football and football training during from Sept to May each year (no.50) Netball & Cricket Club-use the courts for training May – September. (50)

Ludwell Primary School will be able to provide tennis lessons for children and sports After School Clubs which will increase the opportunity for children to play and participate creating healthier more active children. It will also provide a social meeting place for parents to meet and even play a sport themselves - providing an opportunity to encourage people to become more active. Donhead Sports Club, which incorporates tennis, football, netball and cricket - by improving the multi use courts the project will help the Club to continue with the active participation in sport for over 166 members adult and children (with visiting teams this number will increase to over 300) creating a sustainable sports/recreational area for all to enjoy.Social Events'; a Sports Week takes place once a year, fundraising/social events' bingo, barbeques & a firework party in November. These are well known local events - all the community come along and enjoy, which nutures community cohesion and reduces rural isolation, particularly as the events are in walking/cycling distance - people attending the social events will see the sporting opportunities available. This project will improve a rural environment which the community will be better able to access and enjoy creating the opportunites for a healthy lifestyle and having fun! We know this will make a difference to peoples' lives, without it there would be nothing.
