Drawing on their experience running projects in Trowbridge schools with high indices of deprivation, they invited Chippenham Primary Schools to take part in creative music work and 5 schools listed above were keen. A very successful pilot project was completed in October. Research shows that children engaged in music and creativity are more likely to thrive academically and socially than those denied these opportunities. If encouraged to develop these interests when young, children are more likely to engage in creative activities as they grow into their teens, leading to a stronger sense of purpose and fulfilment.
