Important: Please do not type in paragraphs - This section is limited to 1200 characters only (inclusive of spaces) Our programme of summer activities takes in the 2 most socially deprived areas of Calne and one of the 3 most deprived wards in Wiltshire (according to the indicies of deprivation 2000. Many local families on low incomes can not afford a family holiday or to use expensive leisure provisions and many other schemes organised for young people in the area focus upon older children. The project aims to involve children in a wide range of activities everyday that they may not otherwise have an opportunity to experience, including art, craft, sports and games. We have a fundraising programme which enables us to offer free and half price places to families on low incomes. We will provide up to 80 places per day and include extra support for children with disabilities so that they are not excluded from the activities which their friends and siblings are involved in. Parents suffering the effects of deprivation often suffer low self esteem. We encourage and support parents to become involved as committee members and volunteers which may develop confidence and experience in engaging with their own children, other adults and authorities. Any other information about your project. We employ local people, all of whom are CRB checked and involve lots of local volunteers. All staff are given 3 evenings of training/induction before the scheme starts and new staff work alongside experienced ones to ensure policies and procedures are followed safely. We have secured funding from Calne Town Council and the Wiltshire and Swindon Community Foundation grass roots fund for the running costs of this project. We understand that Wiltshire Council does not fund running costs and so this grant would be used towards funding facilitated activities and events (please see financial information) We aim to engage specialist facilitators and equipment to provide up to 10 sessions of activities and experiences over the 4weeks, which will add extra value and fun to the scheme and will increase it's benefit to the community.

Although we consider each Playscheme to be a separate project, as it attracts different groups of children, this year will be the 14th time that we have run the Summer Fun in Calne playscheme, we have an ongoing programme of funding activities and would hope that we will continue to be successful in attracting sponsorship and grant aid in the future.
