Salisbury ranks 18th out of 20th in the JSNA. Violent crime (which includes omestic violence) has been identified as a priority area in the Wiltshire Community Safety Partnership Strategic Assessments Sept.2010. We have regular referrals from Health Visitors, Social care, Army Welfare and schools and Spliz who have identified women and children who are severely affected by DV. We have a close partnership with Salisbury refuge and offer women a chance to make positive and long lasting changes to the life of their family life.
