1. What is the event / initiative?

Baydon – Queen’s Diamond Jubilee Celebrations

Baydon is applying for £500 financial assistance towards our local celebrations

2. Where is the event / initiative taking place?

Baydon Cricket Field, Ermin Street, Baydon. (Within the Marlborough Community Area)

3. When will the event / initiative take place?

4. What are the Community benefits / links to Community Plan?

All age groups have been considered by the Jubilee Committee and the event is being planned to engage with and appeal to all the residents of Baydon with regard to content, access and toilet facilities etc. The recent Village Plan consultation revealed a desire for more community events within the village.

Bouncy castle mini Olympics with staff to man at a cost of £400 for 4 hours.

All children to be presented with a Jubilee mug at a cost of £700/750 (exact figure to be confirmed by end of January 2012.) It is hoped this cost will be funded by the Parish Council.

It is appreciated that this amount may be greater than an award, but the Parish Council has offered to make a contribution towards costs.
