

<p>Marlborough Area Board – Fund towards celebrations for the Jubilee / Olympics</p> <p>From East Kennett Parish</p>
<p>1. What is the event / initiative?</p>
<p>A Jubilee Lunch Party for the village of East Kennett – free to all who would like to attend – offering activities including a rounders match, cupcake competition, face painting, an inflatable slide and BBQ.</p>
<p>2. Where is the event / initiative taking place?</p>
<p>The party will be held in the Village.</p>
<p>3. When will the event / initiative take place?</p>
<p>Tuesday 5 June 2012</p>
<p>4. What are the Community benefits / links to Community Plan?</p>
<p>East Kennett has no Community Plan. However, the community benefits would be huge. As a spread-out rural village with no pub, school, playground, shop or village hall, there are restricted opportunities to gather as a community. This would also encourage young and old alike to integrate.</p>
<p>5. What is the desired outcome of this event / initiative?</p>
<p>By laying on a celebration that everyone of all ages and financial position can enjoy equally, our desire is to encourage social cohesion and more interaction amongst the villagers.</p>
<p>6. Who will Project Manage this event / initiative?</p>
<p>A small committee of villagers.</p>
<p>7. Costs/quotes/ match funding?</p>
<p>An approximation of basic costs include: Food for BBQ - £250. Inflatable slide - £100. Jubilee momentos for village children - £70. Hire of trestle tables & chairs – free of charge from Kennett Valley Village Hall. Tableware & decorations - £150. Prizes - £50. Any additional costs will need to rely on sponsors, donations and the goodwill of villagers, but we are determined to lay on an event that is free of charge to the people of East Kennett. We are hoping to secure a grant of £500.</p>
