Any other information about your project. The village green has been used in SDC publicity literature and has regularly formed the backdrop to articles in the press. Indeed the latest book on Nomansland refers to the cricket scene on the village green and the stunning views towards Landford Wood. The pavilion is annually used by Nomansland Sports Association in their fund raising activities and by the wider community on special occasions. The Cricket Club regularly mobilise a dedicated team of about ten volunteers to maintain the site, so that it is in pristine condition for cricket and visitors. The traditional rural scene of cricket on the village green attracts many visitors and their families from far and wide to enjoy peace and quiet of the countryside, which adds benefit to local community and business. Also outdoor cricket nets have been installed at Nomansland Recreation Ground to improve the performance of the player. The club regularly provide cricket coaching to pupils of the local primary school.
