Ashton Keynes, like many rural communities suffers from rural isolation because of a lack of public transport. Those who are not car owners, children in particular, are largely constrained to the parish environments. It is important therefore to provide as wide a range of activities as possible.

How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

Ashton Keynes Cricket Club is a fundamental part of our village life. It draws its players and members largely from the village itself. Some 10 years ago, the club started a junior section which has proved to be a significant development in ensuring that village cricket remains strong in Ashton Keynes, The club accommodates players from the age of 6 upwards. Besides the senior teams, the club has competitive teams at U9, U11, U13 and U15. In 2011 we expect to have an U17 team. As the number of teams has risen and the ability of the players has improved, there is pressure to prepare more and more tracks (pitches) within the confines of "the square". The quality of the track should be such that it makes playing a pleasurable experience. To this end the club invests a significant proportion of its income in insuring that the square has an annual overhaul. The day to day maintenance is manual which means that we cannot dedicate enough time to the eradication of weeds and other pests which conspire to make parts of the square less than suitable for play. This sprayer will help considerably in achieving the best outcome

The maintenance of the square is carried out by volunteers. The annual overhaul is done on a professional basis by the county pitch advisor. The only mechanised equipment we have is the mower, the rest is "hand cranked". At the moment, fertiliser and weed, moss and worm killer is applied by manual sprayer which gives uneven application and a very unsatisfactory result.
