By engaging the community with the project, there will be strong links formed between the military at Larkhill and the surrounding civilian areas, including schools of Larkhill, Durrington, Shrewton and Amesbury, all with a shared interest in the Stonehenge landscape The Garrison in Larkhill are fully backing this project which has meant that for the first time, recruits will have an impact on the community 'outside the wire' with the support of the military staff who train them.
