Funding this application might be seen as duplication unless it can be proven that this application sits outside our Community Plan and serves an altogether different purpose.</p> <p>2) The application meets grant criteria 2012/13</p> <p>3) The application demonstrates a link to the Community Plan and to the Bemerton Ward Plan 2010 (Appendix 1b)</p> <p>4) The application meets locally agreed/area board priorities</p> <p>5) Summary details about applicant: The Bemerton Heath Interagency Group (IAG) is a multi-agency forum consisting of key stakeholders both statutory and voluntary and representatives of the local community for discussion of and joint action planning on issues relating to the community of Bemerton Ward.
