- To inform the development of policies within the Plans and Strategies being prepared by the Council and others

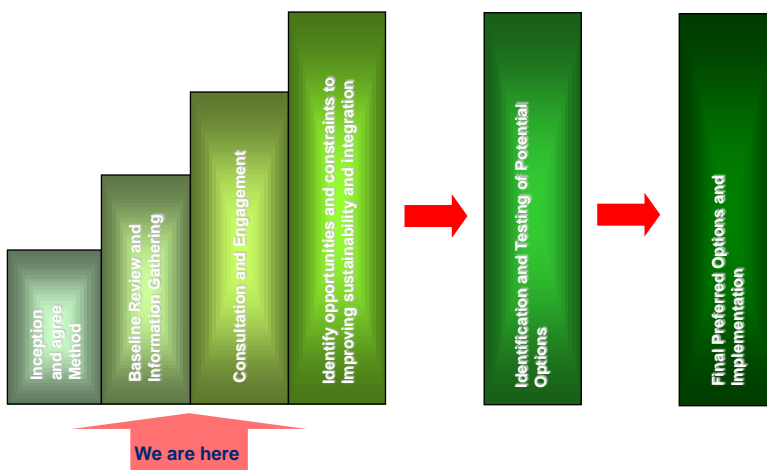

Transport and Connectivity	What are the main benefits and problems of having a significant military presence in the community?
Community and Governance	Should military and civilian communities be more integrated – what are the pros and cons of this?
Place Shaping and Buildings	What are the main constraints to achieving the better integration of civilian and military communities in the area?
Business, Economy, Skills and Education	What works well (and what does not) in the area - existing examples of facilities and initiatives encouraging military and civilian integration?
Climate and Energy	What future actions, initiatives and projects could have the biggest positive impact in the area for community integration and sustainability more widely (see opposite)?
