This will provide a space to get our youngsters off the streets and a chance to get involved in supervised constructive activities as well as a place to socialise. We aim to extend the facilities to include a sheltered outside area for skateboarding, basketball and the like. Once up and running, we hope that all members of the community can benefit from this extra community space.

In association, the youth group need their own space to function. We hope that by providing this facility we hope to reduce low level petty crime/vandalism attributed to teenage boredom. By giving this age group primarily something to do and somewhere to go, we hope that some of our disenfranchised youths will want to join in and take part. We intend to use solar and wind power, low energy lighting, FSC timber as much as possible.
