REDUCING UNNECESSARY STREETLIGHTING

PROPOSALS FROM LAVERSTOCK AND FORD PC

Summary

This report deals with the application to switch off street lighting between 24:00hr and 05:30hrs at identified locations which have been consulted upon locally and technically assessed by Highways (see attached map)

Proposal

The Area Board is asked to consider proposals submitted by Laverstock and Ford Parish Council to switch off street lighting between 24:00hr and 05:30hrs at the identified location which has been consulted upon locally and technically assessed by Highways.

The consultation results, carried out by the Parish Council, were as follows:

Survey results for street lighting reduction survey – Closed 7th Sept.

Derek ,Steve and David distributed 108 letters to affected houses in Church Road, Riverside Road and Willow Close.

There were 35 responses , 26 returned to Steve's house plus 9 people voted on-line.

The 'turnout' was 32%.

24 people voted 'Yes' 69%

11 People voted 'No'. 31%

Reasons For Proposal

This proposal supports and implements Wiltshire Council's Reducing Unnecessary Lighting Project. Laverstock and Ford Parish Council has voted to switch off the selected lights at its meeting on 17 September 2012.

Recommendation

To approve the assessed proposals totalling 20 streetlights on Church Road, Laverstock. Assessments at appendix 1
