The artist will teach us about creating a piece of art that is personal, and each young person can excel on their own canvas. The canvas is then the young persons to keep- as a proud piece of artwork. These 4 sessions will take us through the learning, practise and then final completion of the work, with time at the end to evaluate the end product and whole experience.</p>
