Please briefly tell us about the project /activity you want to organise and why <i>Important: This section is limited to 600 characters only (inclusive of spaces).</i>	We are a group of local parents who assembled in 2010 (on advice of Wiltshire Council officers & local community board) to campaign & design & raise funds for the refurbishment of Barton Farm Play Area in BoA. We felt the play facilities were increasingly derelict & underused and knew many families drive elsewhere to play. In 2010 & 2011, we conducted extensive consultation (with no funds), to ensure that our designs met the needs of the whole community & all age groups. Since Jan 2012 we have been working with BoA Town Council. We now need funds to move a tree to the site for sculpting.

 Since working with the Town Council, we have developed fully-worked up scheme designs for both Barton Farm & Victory Fields play areas, which have been approved by both the council and public. The designs feature extensive use of durable, natural materials, facility for different sorts of play, spaces for sitting & gathering (a request by teenagers), & spaces for sitting & watching children (a request by grandparents). The designs make use of the topography of each site; details & materials suited to the natural & historic BoA context. The public were consulted on a) what they wanted b) initial scheme ideas and c) final scheme designs. We are trying to ensure that the needs of all ages & abilities / disabilities are met through a beautiful, accessible & environmentally-sustainable design, drawing on our passion & professional expertise. To kick-start it, this small grant would fund moving a tree, to be worked in-situ by a local artist into a beautiful seat/play sculpture.
