The Wilton Community Area Partnership was dissolved in 2012.

(Limited to a 1000 characters)</b> In relation to the above point, it seems the last community plan was for 2004 - 2009 and has not been updated, so it's difficult to link this to a specific objective or agenda - I hope this doesn't disqualify this application. However, many of our players fall under the Salisbury area which does have a Community Area Plan. In the Culture and Leisure Section (see link below) there are references to the need for a healthy balance between work and leisure, and that mental well-being is supported by physical health.
