Notification of Intention to Conduct Business in Private

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following item for the Cabinet Capital Assets Committee on 19 March 2013 is likely to be considered in private:

Key Transformation Programme: Strategic Funding Opportunity - Football

That the CCAC supports the allocation of funds to deliver an Artificial Turf Pitch that will contribute towards the wider strategic funding bid from the Football Association and deliver facilities in the County.

The reason that the item is likely to be considered in private is that it will involve the disclosure of exempt information under the following category of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972:

Paragraph 3 - Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding the information)

In accordance with the regulation listed above, as the notice was not published at least 28 clear days before the meeting, agreement has been obtained from the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Management Committee to conduct the item in private.

The reason for the urgency of the item and why it cannot reasonably be delayed is as follows:

To act on very recent negotiations with the Football Association and not lose the opportunity to make a bid for funding.
