How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

We have been an integral part of the community for over 50yrs. The Cricket Club moved from another ground locally 20yrs ago and is now positioned in an idyllic location in the centre of the village opposite the village green and next to the canal. We has strong village community roots and work together with the village and PCC. We encourage new team members including youngsters. We feel that we encourage fitness and teamwork in the community. We also support rural business for example the local pub, as after the matches the teams all go to the pub for refreshment and a meeting about the match. We have changing rooms, which are old and need urgent repairs. The roof is leaking and also has asbestos on it. The toilets and showers need replacing and the inside needs a general repair and repaint. The Club this year has already started fundraising by various ideas, including a Pledge which all the Club is working towards raising a certain amount of money by various means. There is also going to be a fundraising 6 a side fun day match in the summer and also a fathers and sons cricket match, with all the funds going towards the Club.

Having been part of the community for the last 50yrs and for some period before the war, we feel it important to keep the Club alive for future generations. Under present Health and Safety rules and regulations, our changing rooms at present barely comply. All ages from young to the elderly come to watch the cricket, which is in the heart of the village. Some of the elderly and disabled love to watch the games from the back of the ir gardens. We would also be using a local company for the alteration works, both partners of the company live in the village.
