Headlines/Key Issues

- Corsham for Walking Group – The application for Walkers are Welcome status has been sent off for, we hope, accreditation within the next few weeks, and plans are well underway now for Corsham’s first-ever walking festival on Saturday 28 June. - Armed Forces Summer Fete – Taking place on Saturday 5 July, from noon-4pm. All the usual stalls, entertainment and fun, plus a Dog Show and – weather permitting – a flypast by a Hurricane and Spitfire from the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight (time to be confirmed).

- First World War Commemorations – There is a great deal of activity in the community regarding the Great War commemorations, with a number of events planned, including – on 19 August – here at the Town Hall, the re-enactment of a WW1 Recruiting Office.
