<u>Agenda Item No.</u>	<u>Summary of Issues Discussed and Decision</u>
1	<p><u>Chairman's Welcome and Introductions</u></p> <p>The Chairman welcomed everyone to the additional Calne Area Board and introduced the Councillors and Officers present.</p>
2	<p><u>Apologies for Absence</u></p> <p>No apologies were received.</p>
3	<p><u>Declarations of Interest</u></p> <p>There were no declarations of interest.</p>
4	<p><u>Area Board Funding</u></p> <p>Two applications to the Community Area Grants Scheme were considered:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">1) Cherhill Village Hall – a £400 community area grant was awarded to provide a projector screen.</p> <p>Mobile CCTV unit – a Councillor led initiative was considered which contributed £10,000 towards a mobile CCTV resource in conjunction with Chippenham Area Board and Corsham Area Board. The proposal from Alan Hill was to approve the initiative of £10,000 towards the mobile CCTV van project with up to an additional £5,000 delegated to the CAM and Chairman to be used in the event that The Corsham Area Board does not fully support this initiative. Insp. Mawson provided background on the proposal and explained that there was no possibility of funding from the Police and Crime Commission. It was stated that there is to be reports to the Area Boards on the unit's usage. Inspector Mawson stressed that Calne would receive its fair usage of the unit and that the police are to pay the maintenance costs after the initial purchase.</p> <p><u>Return of literacy grant</u></p> <p>Cherhill Village Hall Digital literacy grant – the committee noted the return of an award of £499 made to Cherhill Village Hall on 4th February.</p>
5	<p><u>Close</u></p> <p>The next Area Board meeting is to be held at Calne Town Hall, Bank House, The Strand, Calne, SN11 0EN on Tuesday 8th April at 19:00.</p>
