Please tell us about the project /activity you want to organise/deliver and why? <i>Important: This section is limited to 900 characters only (inclusive of spaces).</i>	<p><i>In 2012, the Chippenham Partnership of Schools worked in partnership with Chippenham Town Council to deliver a 6-day event for over 1000 children in the community area. Days 1-5 were targeted at Year 5 & 6 children, and day 6 at children with special education needs and/or disability (SEND); this sixth day was delivered at Hardenhuish School.</i></p> <p><i>The Chippenham Games, a legacy event was delivered in 2013, and because of the success of previous events in promoting healthy lifestyles, transition into secondary schools, exit routes to sports clubs in the Chippenham area and the fact we also use Young Sports Leaders from the 3 secondary schools to lead activities, act as role models and experience the benefits of volunteering in the community we wish to repeat the event in 2014.</i></p>
