## **Headlines**

• Planning Application (14/01293/OUT)

The application to erect 6 dwellings at Oak Tree Barn was considered at length by the Parish Council and, in a majority decision, it was decided to make a number of comments to Wiltshire Council, but not otherwise object to, outline planning permission being granted.

• <u>Highways - Missing signage at the end of Fivethorn Lane</u>
Given the length of time that this request has been outstanding, it was agreed that the Parish Council would organise its own volunteer working party to rectify the missing signage.

• Seagry Spitfire Memorial Project

A resident addressed the Parish Council with regard to his proposal to have a memorial erected to two spitfire pilots who lost their lives over Seagry in a mid-air collision during the Second World War. Research has already unearthed a considerable amount of the history surrounding the incident and the proposal would be to have a fund raising event, to be held at the Goss Croft Hall. Following consideration the Parish Council gave its unanimous support to the project.
