





HEALTH VISITOR DROP IN CLINIC & MEET AND GREET

Open to all for a chance to socialise, meet new people and access information. Health Visitors provide a baby weighing service and advice. The Children's Centre Worker, Community Development Worker and the Welfare staff are available to provide advice and information on a range of subjects including local events and welfare issues. Lots of toys for children to play with which develop social skills and imagination.

MESSY MONEKYS

Open to parents/carers and their under 5's. Primary school aged siblings are welcome during school holidays. This session provides messy play opportunities which encourage self-expression, imagination and develop fine motor skills and coordination. Playing with the toys also develops social skills by practising negotiation skills, turn taking and sharing. Hot drinks available for adults and a squash and healthy snack provided for children.

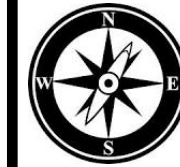


COFFEE MORNING AND PLAY SESSION
