Team News:

There have been no Team changes since the last Area Board Meeting.

2. Performance

Overall reported crime for the last 2-years is static. A breakdown can be found at **Table 1** below. The Community Area increased in size last year with the addition of the Parishes of Staverton and Wingfield. The large residential developments in Staverton have resulted in an increase of the overall population. There has been a significant decrease in Criminal Damage offences.

Updated figures for reported Anti-Social Behaviour can be found at **Table 2** below. It is now possible to compare the 2nd quartile (April – June) 2009 with 2010. I am pleased to report there has been a **13% reduction**.
