This one based in Durrington has been very successful with over 60 young people attending the last one. This project goes some way to developing positive relationships between the young people, adults and local police. Wiltshire Police organise and attend these sessions and have identified that some young people are in need of transport to and from the event for safety reasons and to be able to get to and from the event in a timely fashion otherwise they would be unable to attend owing to the amount of time it would take to get to and from the event and lack of other transport opportunities.</i>
