Conditions and restrictions from transferred licences

Children

No person under fourteen shall be in the par of the licensed premises during the permitted hours unless one of the following applies:

- (3) He is in the bar solel, for the purpose of passing to or from some part of the premises which is not a bar and to or from which there is no other convenient means of access or egress.
- (4) The bar is in railway refreshment rooms or other premises constructed, fitted and intended to be used bona fide for any purpose to which the holding of the licence is ancillary.

In this condition "bar" includes any place exclusively or mainly used for the consumption of intoxicating liquor. But an area is not a bar when it is usual for it to be, and it is, set apart for the service of table meals and alcohol is only sold or supplied to persons as an ancillary to their table meals

Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The provision of Regulated Entertainment, including the provision of facilities is only permitted indoors.

No more than 100 persons may be present on the premises at any one time.

Seating must be provided for at least 60 persons.

Drinking water must be available free or charge at all times.

Members of the public are prohibited from bringing bottles or glasses onto the premises.

Customers are prohibited from the average the premises with drinks in open containers.

All bottles and glasses must be removed from public areas as soon as they are empty or finished with.

A 'customer conduct' poster must be displayed on the premises advising that inappropriate behaviour could lead to being banned from the premises.

All public areas must be adequately lit at all times.

Amplified music must not be played at such a level as to be like y to cause unreasonable disturbance to local residents.

All doors and windows must be kept closed after 2300h and at all times when Regulated Entertainment takes place, except for across and egroes.

All entrance and exit doors must have a lobby entrance.

Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all bublic exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residence and to leave me area quietly.

A written proof of age policy must be n torce requiring the production of identity cards. All staff must be trained in the policy.

A prominent, clear and legible notice must be displayed advising that it is an offence for persons under the age of 18 to our chase or attempt to purchase alcohol.
