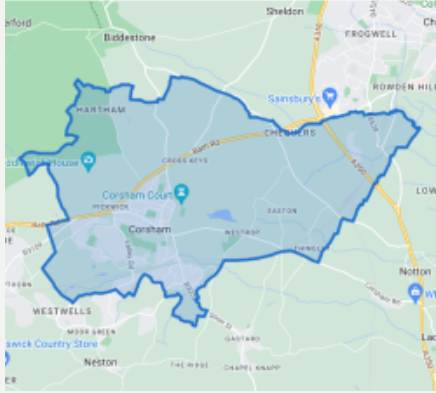

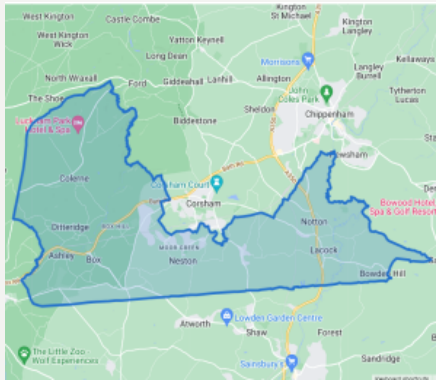

# Community Engagements January – December 2023

Between January and December 2023 the Neighbourhood Policing Team completed **307 community engagements** within the Corsham Town and Rural beat areas.

## Week of Action

The Neighbourhood Policing Team conducted a week of action between 27<sup>th</sup> November and 1<sup>st</sup> December 2023.

### **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> November - Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking**

Officers carried out immigration and welfare checks at local businesses and visited various nail bars, car washes and building sites in the area to identify any potential offences related to immigration, modern slavery and human trafficking.

### **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> November – Misuse of Drugs Act Warrant**

### **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December – Speed Checks / Drink Drive Op**

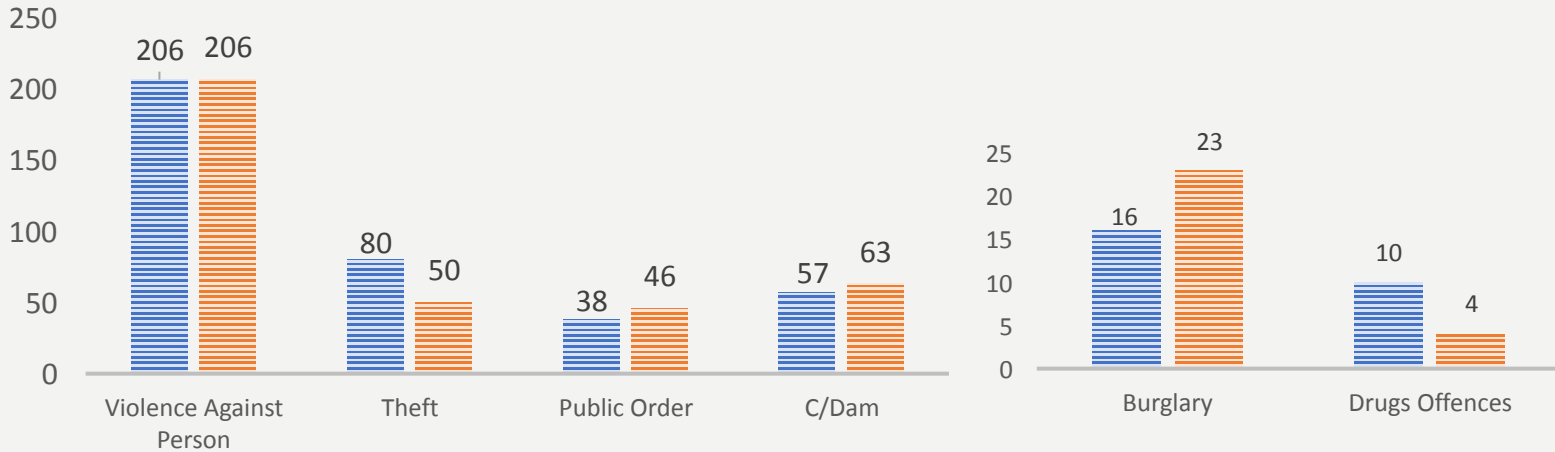
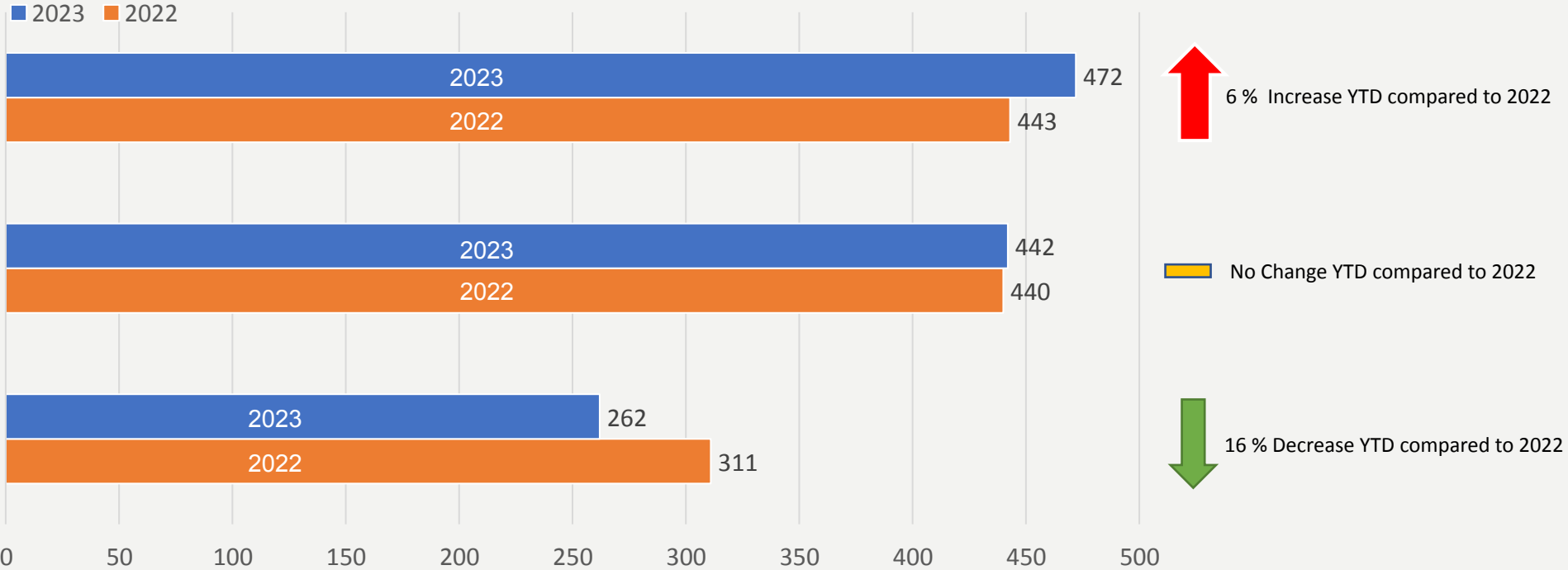
### **OP Sceptre – 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> November 2023**
